The Organising Committee of TransMATTER 2026 is delighted to invite you to submit abstracts for oral and poster presentations.

- Early Bird Abstract Submission commences on: 10th April, 2026
- Submission closes on: 25th May, 2026
- Late-breaking submission closes on: 25th June, 2026

Guidelines for Abstract submission:

- All abstracts must be submitted electronically in English, using the online submission portal
- Abstracts must conform to the overall theme or designated thrust areas of TransMATTER 2026
- All alterations and corrections must be executed before the deadline
- Abstracts are mandatory for both Podium presentations and Poster presentations under the following presentation formats: Podium presentation (8 + 2 minutes Q&A)
- Posters are equally submitted as abstracts related to the respective areas
- The first, second and third choices of the thrust area must be specified to assist us in assigning the abstract to any other area if the first choice is not feasible or available
- The number of authors is limited to 20 altogether
- The presenter is responsible for the compliance with data protection, copyrights, ethical and clinical regulations and laws on animal protection
- Results that have already been published or presented elsewhere cannot be submitted in TransMATTER 2026
- The submitting author will be notified by email about the acceptance (or refusal) of the abstract for presentation in TransMatter 2026, subsequent to the reviewing process

Abstract Details:

- *Title*: The title should be relevant, clear, to-the-point, and concise. The text has to be orthographically suitable for publishing. The abstract title should be written in mixed case (not only capital letters) and with no period at the end of the title.
- *Author(s) and Affiliation(s)*: List of all the authors/co-authors with their affiliation(s) is mandatory. e.g. Presenter, and Co-author(s), Corresponding author*
- Presentation Category: Oral Presentation/Poster Presentation
- Choice of Thrust Area 1, 2, and 3 (Select and suggest the relevant choices [HERE.](#))

(a) Abstract:

Abstract for general participants: The abstract text must be limited to a maximum of **300 words**, offering a concise overview of the research problem, including essential definitions, and identifying the gap that the study aims to address

- The primary research hypothesis should be stated clearly
- Abstract can have a maximum of one figure/scheme/flow chart of 1.5”x6.0” or 3”x3”, which will be equivalent to 120 words. Total words in the abstract, including all contents should not exceed one page.
- The experimental approach should be summarized and its significance stated in relation to the research question presented, avoiding detailed procedural descriptions
- A brief overview of key findings and trends should be provided, linking them to the research problem, and incorporating both qualitative and quantitative data
- The significance of the results should be discussed, and their implications for the broader research topic or question should be analysed
- Abbreviations must be defined at first usage

(b) Abstract under Young researcher Award category:

- The limit for the abstract under this category is **500 words**.
- Abstract can have a maximum of one figure/scheme/flow chart of 1.5”x6.0” or 3”x3”, which will be equivalent to 120 words.
- The usage of special formatting should be limited since correct replication in all media cannot be granted.
- A maximum of two references may be added.
- It is not allowed to submit an abstract several times to different subjects of the conference.

• All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee of TransMATTER 2026 and assigned the most appropriate format based on quality, relevance, and fit with thematic sessions. However, this decision will be final and will rest with the Scientific Committee of TransMATTER 2026.

• Review criteria–

- Aim and objective (rationale and importance clearly defined),
- Material and Methodology (adequately designed),
- Results (complete, clear, statistically analysed)
- Conclusions (critical, well-deduced, current literature).
- Abstracts that show formal errors (multi-submission, already published) will be rejected.

Presenting author's name should be underlined and the corresponding email should be mentioned at the bottom of the page. Address should be complete with the name of the institute, city, postal code and country. Use Times New Roman font and size 12 for the address, abstract body and figure caption. Full Abstract should be limited to 1 page. The page margins (Top 2.2 cm, bottom 1.85 cm, left/right 3cm) of the template **SHOULD NOT BE** changed. It should be **no more than 300 words, excluding references, title, authors**.

Presenting author's name should be underlined and the corresponding email should be mentioned at the bottom of the page. Address should be complete with the name of the institute, city, postal code and country. Use Times New Roman font and size 12 for the address, abstract body and figure caption. Add references [1], limited to a maximum of three at the end in the specified format. The page margins (Top 2.2 cm, bottom 1.85 cm, left/right 3cm) of the template SHOULD NOT BE changed. A **maximum of six keywords** may be included. It should be **no more than 500 words, excluding references, title, authors**.
